## About CPM

CPM started in 1989 as an artist led initiative serving Northern NSW and SE Queensland. Situated in the outskirts of Murwillumbah, CPM provides facilities for etching, lithography, photography, relief and screen printing. The Workshop Gallery provides members an opportunity to exhibit their work. CPM has an inclusive, multi-media focus where artists of all levels of experience and in all disciplines are welcome to share insights and workshop practices. CPM is a non-profit, incorporated group financed through membership fees and supported by Regional Arts NSW, Ministry of the Arts NSW, Tweed Shire Council and local businesses.

The Workshop Gallery is open to the public Friday to Sunday 11am till 3pm or by appointment. It offers visitors the opportunity to meet the members, tour the workshop and view and purchase art from the collection.

CPM is also responsible with the co-operation of the Tweed Regional Art Gallery for the organisation of the biennial CPM National Print Awards. These fall every odd-numbered year from the beginning of April until the end of May. See the CPM website for further details and entry form.

## Membership of CPM

CPM is not a teaching institution but is primarily an open-access studio for artists. Prospective members are encouraged to familiarise themselves with the studio by visiting on any open day. Formal workshops are offered when there is sufficient interest. Membership of CPM entitles you to newsletters, exhibition space, workshop facilities (additional fee applies), materials at cost and participation in group exhibitions and collaborative projects.

## CPM committee meetings

Meetings are held on the second Saturday of each even-numbered month at 1.30pm followed by an exhibition opening at 3pm where all are welcome. For further information phone (02) 66728276 or email [info@cpmprintstudio.com](mailto:info@cpmprintstudio.com).

## Use of the Workshop

The workshop is available for all members to use for either an annual fee of \$120 per year (pro rata per quarter) or for a casual rate of \$5 per half day (<3 hours) or \$10 per day (>3 hours). Those who volunteer to be on the roster are entitled to free use of the workshop for the period they are on duty. The keys to the facility are available at the grocery/bottle shop store up the road upon the showing of your membership card. Those on the roster can request their own copy of the keys upon the payment of a \$20 deposit.

All equipment is available to members who can demonstrate proficiency and understanding of OH&S standards. Owing to the dangers associated with machinery and chemicals, children, if present, must be supervised at all times.

## Consumables

Papers, inks, solvents and chemicals are available for purchase at CPM. These items are not included in the workshop hire fee. A cost guide is posted in the office area. The workshop runs on an honour system and members are responsible for recording and processing their own payments and receipts in the day book in the office.

## Workshop Gallery

The Workshop Gallery is available for the display of members works only. The cost of gallery hire for approximately 8 weeks is \$120 paid prior to the exhibition opening. Exhibition openings are the responsibility of the artists and are usually held at 3pm following the committee meetings on the second Saturday of each even-numbered month. Exhibition proposals are invited each June and November. The gallery is to be restored to its original condition on completion of the exhibition. Exhibiting artists are encouraged to share roster on open days for the duration of their exhibition and will be first called if a volunteer is unable to attend.

# CPM Membership Application Form

There are two levels of membership - Active members pay a one off calendar year fee which gives them unlimited access (except when workshops are under-way) to the workshop facilities and equipment. These members do not have to sign in each time they use the facilities. This fee is pro rata reduced each quarter. Inactive or Friends of CPM membership is for those who make little or no use of the workshop and instead wish to pay a daily or half daily rate of \$12 or \$6 respectively. These members are required to sign in to use the facilities.

The gallery is manned by volunteers only and to enable us to open the hours that we advertise it is important that all members participate in the roster whenever possible. Similarly there are a number of tasks which need to be undertaken on an ad-hoc basis such as working bees, publicity, website management, general administration, assistance with exhibitions etc. Please indicate your availability to assist with these important tasks.
